



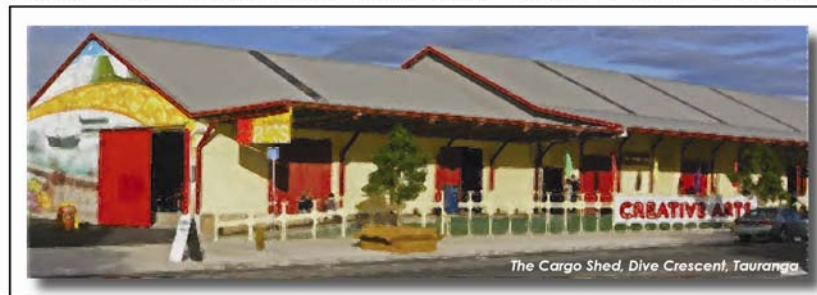
INSPIRING CREATIVITY AND DIVERSITY OF THOSE INVOLVED WITH THE CARGO SHED

The Cargo Shed located on Dive Crescent, Tauranga has been operating since November 2004. In April 2009 Creative Tauranga Charitable Trust took over the management of The Cargo Shed with the vision to provide a multifunctional space that will grow and enhance the local arts sector. Creative Tauranga will work towards developing more exhibition opportunities, art making spaces for local artists and a vibrant market filled with New Zealand made, New Zealand designed products and services together with Tauranga based Charitable Trusts.

Creative Tauranga have been generously assisted by local businesses Placemakers, Riddell Construction, Hirepool, MacMurdo Electrical, Armstrong Plumbing, Smarts and the Department of Corrections on an internal makeover to fit with our vision – just brushing back the original woodwork alone has made a huge difference to the ambience of this fabulous historical site, and we have plans to further celebrate the heritage of this site with stories and visuals of The Cargo Shed as it was many years ago.

The purpose of Creative Tauranga is to empower and inspire participation in creativity. The Cargo Shed is an opportunity for local and national artists to exhibit and sell their high quality original artworks. Arts and Crafts include carving, ceramics, drawing, fibre, glass, jewellery, leather, metal, mixed media, music, painting, photography, printmaking, textiles, toi māori, sculpture, weaving, wood, specialty items and more. Creative Tauranga provides practical support for artists and art groups: from those just starting out to experienced artists. There are many options designed to suit individual needs, such as working space available that can be utilised during the days The Cargo Shed is not open to the public. The Cargo Shed will also have regular farmer's market style produce available together with specialty prepared foods.

The Cargo Shed will initially be open for a twilight market featuring Tauranga Farmers Market artisans on Wednesdays - and creative art market weekends on Saturdays and Sundays. The weekends will be filled with free art and craft demonstrations by artists and art groups, buskers, poets and story tellers. Businesses, schools, individuals and/or community groups have an opportunity to rent exhibition space for private events/fundraising on application. Interested?
